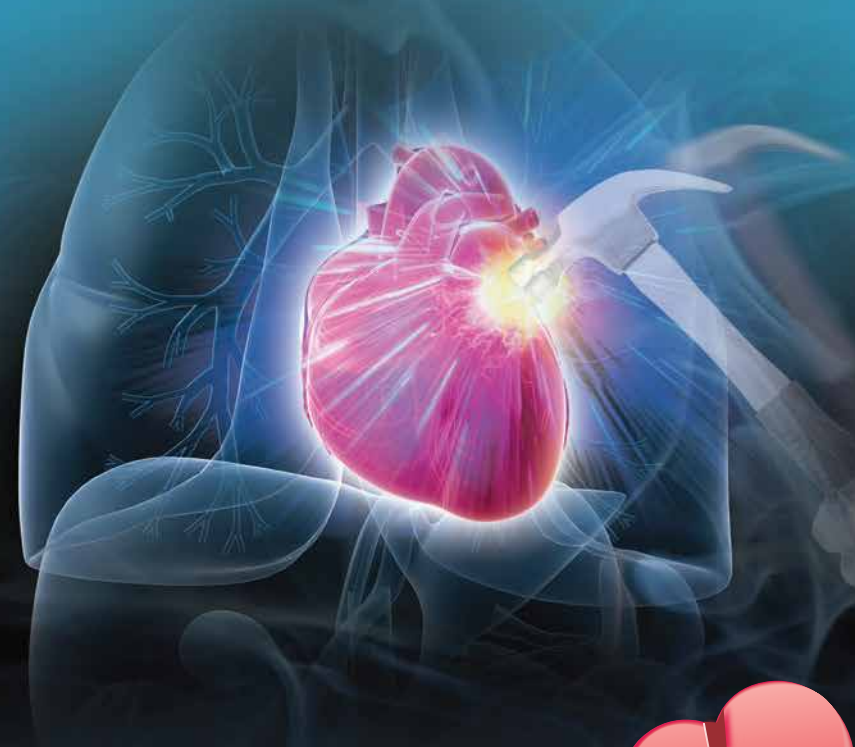

Dr Chuang Hsuan-Hung completed his cardiology fellowship training at the National Heart Centre of Singapore. He was subsequently awarded two scholarships to the Cleveland Clinic Foundation in Ohio. During his two-year stint, he sub-specialized in heart failure and heart transplant intensive care and advanced cardiovascular imaging. In 2006, he spent a sabbatical period as a fellow at the Lenox Hill Hospital in New York, for training in cardiac and peripheral CT. He was formerly a Clinical Lecturer at the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine at the National University of Singapore and with the American College of Sports Medicine. He has been an advisor to the Aeromedical Centre of Singapore and Singapore Sports Council, and has been appointed board member with the Singapore Heart Foundation, council member with Singapore Cardiac Society and Senate board of the Management Development Institute of Singapore (MDIS). His clinical interests are heart failure and mechanical heart support, genetic heart disease and sports cardiology, valvular heart disease, onco-cardiology, and imaging for structural heart disease intervention.

Dr Goh Ping Ping is a Cardiologist who specialises in Echocardiography. She currently practises at Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre. Dr Goh graduated with Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery in 1988 from the National University of Singapore and completed Advanced Specialty Training in Cardiology in 1997. She trained in Echocardiography in the Cleveland Clinic Foundation, USA. She is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians, UK; Fellow of the Academy of Medicine (Cardiology), Singapore; Fellow of the National Board of Echocardiography, USA. She is also the official spokesperson for the Singapore Heart Foundation's Go Red For Women campaign which aims to raise awareness of heart disease among women.

Having completed his cardiology training in Singapore, Dr Guo went on to complete specialized fellowship training in adult congenital heart disease at the Maude unit of the McGill University Heart System in Montreal, Quebec. He was formerly Consultant Cardiologist at National Heart Centre Singapore, Adjunct Assistant Professor at Duke-NUS Graduate Medical School and Clinical Senior Lecturer at National University of Singapore. Currently, Dr Guo practices at Mount Elizabeth Medical Centre, Mount Elizabeth Novena Specialist Centre and Gleneagles Medical Centre. His main research and clinical interest is in both non-invasive and invasive cardiac imaging, and management of adult congenital heart disease, pulmonary arterial hypertension and right heart failure.
